PROFLO[®] Membrane Drain Installation Instructions

RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

- Caulk Gun
- Trowel
- Utility Knife
- Philips Screw Driver
- 7/16" nut driver or socket wrench
- Hammer

Concrete Chisel

Please read all instructions before installing products.

- Tape Measure
- Safety glasses
- Face Shield
- Dust mask
- 4 1/2" & 7" Core Saw



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Pick the membrane drain that is appropriate for your connection type. See pg. 3 for connection type options.

- 2. Drill a 4 1/2" diameter core hole at the drain location.
- 3. Drill a 7" diameter core hole 1 3/8" deep at the drain location and chip out the 7" diameter hole to 1 3/8" deep.
- 4. Install your pipe.

5. Install the drain body on to the pipe so that the top of the flange sits a minimum of either 3/8" or 7/8" below the floor, depending on your receptor type. See below. Verify that the drain body is level.

6. Cement the drain body to the floor.

Note:

- Cover the top of the drain with duct tape or something similar to prevent cement from getting on the top of the drain body or down the drain hole.
- 7. Install the drain manufacturer's recommended membrane per the manufacturer's installation instructions.


Note:

- Apply a bead of silicone to the top outside edge of the drain body before the bladder is installed to create a water tight seal.
- Make a cutout for the drain hole which is slightly larger than the drain hole so the membrane doesn't block the weep holes in the clamping ring.
- Cut small slits where each bolt is so you can press the bolts through the slits.

8. Install the clamping ring.

FLAT BOTTOM RECEPTOR




NOTE: MINIMUM FLANGE HEIGHT IS CRITICAL IN PREVENTING THE FLANGE BOLTS FROM CONTACTING THE UNDERSIDE OF THE SHOWER PAN

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Note:

Make sure that the weep holes are not blocked.

9. Check that your floor is level and apply shims if necessary.

10. Apply mortar per the receptor install instructions.

Note:

Do not get mortar in the drain recess, this can block the weep holes or interfere with the installation of the receptor.

11. Install the receptor per the receptor install instructions.

12. Apply a bead of silicone to the top of the drain flange.

13. Screw the drain into the drain body, make sure the silicone creates a seal between the drain and the drain flange on the receptor.


14. Clean up excess silicone with denatured alcohol.

15. Install the strainer (omit this step if you are installing a "trench" style receptor).
