Use color coordinated caulk to fill in joints and seal seams between solid surface panels and to seal the perimeter around solid surface accessories.

## **BEFORE INSTALLATION:**

• Install wall panels, trim, or accessories per Inpro's installation instructions

Utility Knife

- Acclimate the caulk to the environmentally controlled installation area for 24 hours, prior to installation. This area requires a consistent temperature between 65°-80°F [18°-27°C] and a humidity level less than 80%.
- Clean all surfaces to ensure that they are free of dirt, dust, oil, wax, and other such substances.

• Masking Tape • Paper Towels/Rags Denatured Alcohol




## FASTFILL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Ensure all surfaces are clean, free of dust, oil, wax, or other such substances.
- 2. Apply masking tape to the seam or joint. See Figure 1
- 3. Apply 1/4" caulk bead to the seam or joint. See Figure 2

Note: Ensure FastFill has full contact with the edges of the seam.

4. Smooth caulk into the seam or joint with a caulk finishing tool or finger. See Figure 3



- 5. Remove the masking tape immediately after each joint is completed. *See Figure 4*
- 6. **IMPORTANT** Clean up excess caulk with denatured alcohol before the caulk cures. *See Figure 5*
